A Multi-faculty Institution of Five Decades of Repute

Tiruchy: Jamal Mohamed College, Tiruchy, was founded in 1951 as an affiliated college to the University of Madras and then to Bharathidasan University, Tiruchy, when it was formed in 1984.

The college is administered by the Society of Jamal Mohamed College. It is established in a sprawling land area of 87 acres (60 acres in the present location and 27 acres in Veerampatti near Bharathidasan University) as a religious minority institution with the primary objective of providing higher education to the down-trodden and socially backward sections of the society in general and Muslim minority in particular. Janab M. Jamal Mohamed Sahib and Janab N.M. Khajamian Rowther of revered memory were the founding fathers of this institution. Janab A.K. Khaja Nazemudeen is the present Secretary and Correspondent of the college.

Over the period of five decades, the college was able to scale greater and greater

heights and rise to the present status as a multi-faculty institution with 11 UG courses, 11 PG courses and two MPhil Programmes under Government Aided stream and three UG courses, eight PG courses, 11 MPhil and 11 PhD programmes under self-financing stream by promoting quality and excellence in higher education due to the sustained efforts and dedicated leadership given by the College Management Committee.

The college has grown from strength to strength under the able leadership of greatmen who adorned the seat of Principalship from 1951. Late Alhaji Janab M.J. Mohamed Sayeed MA, LT was the first Principal from 1951 to 1970. Prof EWP Thomas MA was the Principal from 1970 to 1971. Late Haji Prof EP Mohamed Ismail became the Principal in 1971 and held the office upto 1985.

Dr. C Nainar Mohamed MA, PhD, was the Principal from 1985 to 1989. Prof Haji



N Abdul Samadh MA, MPhil, became the next Principal and held the office from 1989 to 1998. Dr K Abdullah Basha MA, MPhil, PhD, was the Principal from 1998 to 2003.

Dr M Shelk Mohamed MCom, MPhil, PhD, FICWA, PGDCA, PGDFM, Dip MA, MBA, MPhil (Mangt) was the Principal during 2003 to 2011.

During 2010-11, the college completed 60 years of its very useful service in higher education and celebrated Diamond Jubilee

with a maximum students strength of 9625 and 383 teaching faculty. Dr R Khader Mohideen, MCom, MPhil, PhD, MBA, was appointed the Principal from 1st June 2011.

The college was accredited at Five Star Level by NAAC during 2002 and conferred with Autonomous Status by UGC, New Delhi and Bharathidasan University in 2004-2005. During Jan 2009, the college was reaccredited with A- grade - CGPA 3.6 out of 4.0.

The college celebrated

Diamond Jubilee functions during 2010-2011. It has adopted Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) giving mobility to the students of UG and PG to study Electives in any discipline they like and to improve their skill in different fields.

Compulsory subjects on Gender Studies, Value Education and Environmental Studies are also taught to UG students and Deeniyyath Education is imparted to Muslim students outside the class hours.

The college strives to

spread the light of knowledge, inculcate ethical values and spirit of service to society and build discipline

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and character in the youth entrusted to its fold so that they become proud citizens of this great nation. It keeps its doors open to all without any distinction of caste, creed or colour.

Research Publications: All the departments in the college are research departments providing facilities to undergo MPhil and PhD programmes and they continuously produce a sizeable number of PhDs and MPhil almost every year. Many of these departments have carried out major and minor

research projects supported by leading funding agencies like UGC, DAE, IAC, INSA, ICSSR, DST, etc. Many of our members of staff have visited foreign countries like Malaysia, Singapore, Indonesia, South Korea, Italy, USA, Canada, Israel, France, Spain, Dubai, Australia, Germany and Mauritius for presenting papers and delivering lectures in their areas of specialisation.

From 2003-2004 onwards, the Jamal Academic Research Journal, an interdisciplinary, bi-annual research journal, was published as a reference journal. Monetary incentives are given to Professors for publication of research articles in reputed journals and guiding scholars in MPhil and PhD programme.

Every year August 15th is celebrated as the Alumni Day. Distinguished Alumnus Award is presented to the selected former students for their contribution in their chosen field.

Scholarships sponsored

by former students under the principle of "Each one Educate one" and from well wishers are distributed every year to meritorious poor students. Alumni Associations of Jamal Mohamed College are functioning abroad and in Chennai.

Many buildings were constructed out of the philanthropic gesture of well wishers and the alumni. Singapore Alumni Chapter celebrated the college Diamond Jubilee in Singapore on 02.05.2011.
